Commissioners Order No 5.

The Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Avon met at the House of Hoit Sabins in said town on this 2nd day of July 1847 at 9 o'clock A.M. to take into consideration the subject of the petition of Ira Hersey and 14 others for the laying of a Highway it being proved to our satisfaction that such notice of our meeting had been given as the law requires we proceeded to examin the ground on the route petitioned for and caused a survey to be made: Commencing on the North side of Town 1 Range 10 at a point 80 rods West of the Northwest corner of Section 4; thence South leaving the Sec. line 80 rods to the left to a point 80 rods w. of S. West corner of Section 16 in said Town; thence South 14 chains and 64 links; thence S. 23° E. 2 Chains and 38 links to a stump; thence S. 3° 3/4 W. 6 Chains and 11 links to the North bank of Sugar River.

And we order and determine that the above described line be the center line of a Public Highway of 4 rods in width.
