At a meeting of the Supervisors of the Town of Avon in said county held in said town of Avon on the 28th day of February A.D. 1855 for the purpose of laying out a highway in said town. It is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors that a highway be laid out commencing at the South East corner of Section one in said town thence running West on the South line of said Section 80 rods to the South West corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section one, and thence running South 160 rods on the Eighty line to the S.W. Corner of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No 12 and thence East on the quarter line 80 rods to the town line of Newark. Said highway to be the width of four rods and the said line to be the center of said road.

In witness whereof we the Supervisors of said town have hereinto set our hands this 28th day of February A.D. 1855.
