At a meeting of the Supervisors of the towns of Avon and Spring Grove in said County of Rock held in said town of Avon on this the 18th day of October 1856 for the purpose of laying out a highway on the line between the said towns it is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors that a highway be laidout upon the line between the said towns: Commencing on the County line at the center of the West line of Section no. 30 in said town of Avon thence running North on said County line to intersect the County line road on the West line of Section 7 and that the said line above discribed be the center line of said highway and that the said highway be of the width of four rods and it is further ordered that the said highway be divided into two road districts as follows: that part thereof from Sugar River South shall be one of said road districts and shall be allotted to the town of Avon and the remainder of said highway shall be the other of said road district and shall be alloted to the town of Spring Grove. In witness where of the said Supervisors have hereunto set their hands, the 18th day of October 1856.
