

NOTICE OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

By virtue of an act of the legislative of the State of Wisconsin entitled "an act" to authorize the supervisors of the Town of Beloit in Rock County to borrow money to build a bridge approved March 31st, 1855. An election is hereby called to be held by the legal voters of the Town of Beloit in the County of Rock on the 18th day of December 1855 at the Beloit House, in the Village of Beloit in said town to decide whether the Board of supervisors of said town shall borrow the sum of ten thousand dollars for the purpose of aiding in the erection of a bridge across Rock River on or near the place where the bridge now stands, and pay for the same in the bonds of said town payable on the first day of January, 1866 with interest payable annually at ten per cent per annum. At said election those voting in favor shall vote a ballot bearing the words inscribed thereon (For the Bridge Loan) and those voting against shall vote a ballot bearing the words inscribed thereon, "Against the Bridge Loan" Dated 4th of December 1855

HIGHWAY

We the undersigned supervisors of said Town of Beloit having ascertained that the public highway therein leading from the Northwest corner of Section 21 Eastward on the North line of said Section 21 to the corner of Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22; thence Eastward on the North line of Section 22, in the direction of the corner of Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, 77 chains and 60 links to the highway from Beloit to Janesville; then beginning on the North line at the center of the East half of Section 21 and running South on the center line of the East half of Sections 21 and 27, 155 chains and 76 links to the Madison Road is encroached upon the West side thereof, along the lands in the occupation of John Dates, by a rail fence erected by the present or same or some former occupant thereof. Which forms a part of the enclosure of said land and having ascertained that the Westerly bounds and limits of said highway to be a line parallel with and 2 rods West of said rail fence.

And that all that strip of land lying between said line and said rail fence is a part of the public highway aforesaid.

It is therefore ordered by the undersigned supervisors of said town that the said rail fence be removed so that the said highway be opened and unobstructed, and of the breadth originally intended, which was four rods within thirty days from the date of the service of this order.
