We the supervisors of the Town of Beloit in the County of Rock and State of Wisconsin met agreeable to previous notice duly made and posted on Saturday the 9th day of February A.D. 1856 at the office of Castle and Parker in said town of Beloit to consider the petition of Daniel Blodgett and more than five other freeholders of said town for the laying out of a highway in said town of Beloit which said highway is described in said petition.

And being satisfied of our own knowledge that the notices required by law had been duly posted and served according to law proceeded to examine the route for the laying out of said highway agreeable to said petition.

And we do hereby order and determine that the course of said highway be and is as follows:

The center line commencing in the center of the road running from Beloit to Sugar River at a point where the center line of Section 34 crosses said road; thence running South on said centerline of Section 34 to the South line of said section or to the State line. And we do further order that the above described highway be of the width of four rods.

ORDER FOR THE REMOVAL OF OBSTRUCTIONS FROM

HIGHWAY

We the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Beloit having ascertained that the public highway therein commencing at a post where the Rockton Road (so called) intersects the Beloit and Madison Road; thence running North  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a mile or thereabouts to the school house situated on Section 6 in said Town of Beloit is encroached upon by a rail fence crossing said highway on the North line of the Beloit and Madison highway on lands in the occupation of Richard Irish and that said highway is further encroached upon by a rail fence crossing the said highway on land in the occupation of Richard Irish, some 55 rods North of said first rail fence, which said fences were erected by the present or by some former occupant thereof which forms a part of the enclosure of said Irish's land.

It is therefore ordered by the undersigned supervisors of the said Town of Beloit that the said rail fences be removed so that the said highway be open and unobstructed and of the breadth originally intended which was four rods within thirty days from the date of the service of this order.
