We the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Beloit in said County of Rock having ascertained that the public highway in said town leading from near the Northwest corner of Section 7 in said town to the Village of Beloit is encroached upon by a board fence crossing said highway on the North side of lands in the occupation of James Cass. Also by a board fence crossing said highway on the East side of same lands in the occupation of James Cass in Section 35 in said town erected by the present or some former occupant thereof which forms a part of the enclosure of said lands, and having ascertained the center line of said highway to be in or upon and according to the following line to wit:

Commencing in the center of the present highway where it intersects the town line between the Towns of Beloit and Newark 38 rods South of the Northwest corner of Section 7, Town 1, Range 12; thence South 45%° East 100 rods to the East line of the West half of the Northwest quarter Section 7: thence South 48° East across the East half of the Northwest quarter cutting the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter and running across the Southeast quarter of Section 7, and onward through the Northwest quarter cutting the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter, 616 rods to a post on the Southeast quarter of Section 17; thence passing through the reminder of the Southeast quarter of Section 17, and onward through the Northwest quarter of Section 21, and crossing the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of the same to a post in the Southeast quarter of the said Section 21, South 37%° East 456 rods; thence through the remainder of the Southeast quarter of Section 21, crossing the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 28, and onward through the Northwest quarter and Southwest quarter and Southeast quarter of Section 27, and onward crossing the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 35, South 44%° East 764 rods to a post 6½ rods East from the Southeast corner of the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section 35 being in the center of the road from Coon Creek to the Village Beloit. It is therefore ordered by the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Beloit that the said board fences be removed so that the said highway be opened and unobstructed and that said board fences be removed beyond the limits of said highway and that said highway be of the breadth originally intended which was four--within thirty days from the date of the service of this order.
