A survey of an alteration in the Hart Prairie and Prairie Dalac Road on the Town line of T. 3 and 4 of R. 14 on the line of Sections 3, 34, 33, 4, beginning at the angle post set by the old survey on the line of Sections 3 and 34 when the said road by the former survey angled North of said line from said place of beginning on the said town line N. 88° 45' W. one mile, two chains and seventy links to where the former survey came onto the the said Townline again.
