Sham house and extending on the Janesville and Waterloo survey to the line of said town also that part of the Beloit road on the town line between Range 12 and 13 from the foot of the hill South of Mr. Cadman's field to the South section corner of Section 1 in Town 2 Range 12 and Section 6 of Range 13 of Town 2, inclduing the following sections to wit: Sections 6, 7, 18, 17, 8, 5, 4, 9, 16 & 15, 10 & 3 in Town 2 Range 13 also 32, 33, 35, of Town 3 Range 13, March 4th, 1843

Road District No. 2

Commencing at the South bank of the creek near the range line on what is called the Beloit River Road; thence North to the Mil-waukee Street in the Village of Janesville; thence on the Milwaukee Territorial road to the top of the hill East of the Second Bridge, also on the Beloit and Watertown Territorial road to where it intersects the road to Humes Ferry including the following.
