Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 25 in the center of the highway leading from Janesville to Milwaukee from thence southerly on the West bounds of Section 25 and 36 to the South bounds of Section 36. T. 3 N., R. 13 from thence Southerly on T. 2 N., R. 13 E. Southerly on the West bounds of Section 1 and 12 and 13 to the South bounds of Section 13, Southwest corner post. Elisha C. Story.

This road is laid out and a half rods from the right of the left of the center. Janesville, June 8th, 1844.
