T. have this 27th day of June 1846 laid out and established a public highway in said town from near the Southwest corner of Sec. 30 in T. 3 N.,R. 13 E. running a Northeast course to its intersection with the Territorial road from Janesville to Milwaukee surveyed and described as follows: Beginning in the range line 25 links North of the Southwest corner of Sec. 30 in T. 3 N.,R. 13 E. and thence N. 57° 50' E. 27 chains and 30 links to center of the Territorial road from Janesville to Milwaukee all in the section above mentioned said road is laid four rods wide, variation of needle 7° 30' E.

And now we the Commissioners aforesaid, in and for said town do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the road as above described to be a public highway, and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.
