Minutes of the survey of a road taken the 15th day of May, 1847 by J. March are as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Sec. 1.T. 2 N.R. 12, W.T.; thence North 89° West on the line between T. 2 and 3, 612 rods to a stake; thence South 66° W. 18½ rods to a stake; thence North 83° W. 8 rods to a stake; thence North 80° W. 18½ rods; thence North 83° W. 132 rods to a quarter post on the North line of Sec. 4; thence 83° W. two miles and 132 rods on the town line to the West line of Sec. 6 making a a distance of five miles and one rod by sections. The town line is to be the center of the road except where it crosses the creek near the corner of Sec. 3 and 4; and the road four rods wide. Variation of the needle 7° E.

I do hereby certify that the above is a true description of the road described; therein called the town line road.
