Notes of a survey of public highway made the 31st day of March 1849 by ordered of the Commissioners. Commencing at the common corner of sections 21, 22, 27 and 28 of T. 3 N., R. 12 E. of 4th principal meridian and running thence East on the North line of Section 27, 40 chains to the quarter post on said line - running thence S. 55 1/4° E. 62 chains to line joining the East and West quarter posts of Section 26 running thence on said line Eastwardly 25 chains 25 links to center of said Sections 26 and running or continuing thence on said line East 21 chains 18 links to center of highway running up Rock River.
Var. of needle 6° 30' N.
