We the undersigned Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville Rock County, Wisconsin have this 31st day of March 1849 laid and established a public highway in said town:

Beginning at the common corner of Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28 of T. 3 N., R. 12 E. of the 4th prinicipal meridian, and running thence East on the North line of Section 27, 40 chains to the quarter post on said line - running thence S. 55%° E. 63 chains to line joining the East and West quarter posts of Sec. 26 - running thence on said line Easterly 25 chains 25 links to center of said section 26, and continuing thence on said line East - 21 chains 18 links to center of highway running up Rock River. O.M.Var. 6° 30' E.

Said road to be four rods wide.

And now we the Commissioners aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written order and declare the road above described to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened as such, pursuant to statute.
