We the undersigned Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin do certify that upon the application of six or more freeholders of said town, asking for the laying out of a road in said town from the West end of Jackson Street at its intersection with road to Madison and running thence to said street through Mitchell, Smith and Bailey's Addition and Smith, Bailey and Stone's Addition to Janesville to its intersection with Union Street, last named addition at the Northeast corner of the Village of Rockport. That we caused notices in writing to be posted up in three of the most public places in same town specifying the commencement and route of the proposed highway, the several tracts of land through which it was proposed to be laid so far as known and the time and place at which we would meet to make examination and survey of the same, which notices were posted up at least six days before said highway meeting and we do further certify that being fully satisfied that the notices required by law have been given pursuant to statute. We on this 15th day of July, 1848 it being the day specified in said notices met at the house and place appointed therein, examined the route of said proposed highway; heard all the reasons offered for or against laying out the same, we are of the opinion that such highway was necessary and proper and proceeded to aly out the same, and cause a survey and description of said road to be made, which survey and description was in words and figures following: Beginning at the West end of Jackson Street at its intersections with road to Madison and running thence on said street through Mitchell, Smith and Bailey's Addition and Smith, Bailey and Stone's Addition to Janesville to its intersection
