were necessary and proper, and proceeded to lay out the same,
And now we the Commissioners aforesaid, in and for the said town do on the 26th day of March A.D. 1850 arder and declare the above descrbed streets to be public highways, and we do further order the same

to be kept open as such pursuant to statute.
