We the supervisors of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin, do certify that upon the application of six ore more freeholders of said town asking for the alteration and laying out of certain roads in the Town of Janesville into public highways to wit:

"That a certain part of the New Madison Road North of the

"That a certain part of the New Madison Road North of the residence of Mrs. Hield is very wet and muddy in the apring and fall. and running through a low piece of ground, it is difficult piece of highway to keep in repair we therefore petition the board of supervisors of the town, to so alter the said highway so as to intersect the old Madison Road, near the aforesaid residence of Mrs. Hield and therefore avoid the mending of the difficulty; and get a shorter distance to the same place upon dry and easier ground."

That we caused notices to be posted up in writing in three of the most public places in said town of Janesville specifying the road above mentioned proposed for a highway and the time and place at which we would meet to make examination of the same. Which notices were posted up at least ten days before said meeting, and we do further certify that being fully satisfied that the notices required by law had been given pursuant to statute; we on this 21st day of September it being the specified time in said notices met at the hour and place named, examined said road proposed for a highway, heard all the reasons offered for and against laying out the same, we are of the opinion that such highway is necessary and proper and against ceeded to lay out the same according to survey made and recorded.

And now we the Super-visors aforesaid in and for said town do on this 21st day of September 1850 order and declare the above described road to be a public highway and we do further order
