Whereas a highway having been laid out by the supervisors of the Town of Janesville in the County of Rock by an order bearing date the 19th day of June 1861 described as follows: The centerline of said highway begins at the Northeast corner of Section 18, Town 3 North, Range 12 East running thence South on the section line between Sections 17 and 18, town and range aforesaid to the Southeast corner of said Section 18; thence East on the section line between Sections 17 and 20, town and range aforesaid to the Northeast corner of the West half of the Northwest quarter of said Section 20, town and range afore said and until it meets and intersects with a public highway running North and South on the East line of the West half of the Northwest quarter of said Section 20, which highway passes through certain lands owned by me described as follows: The West half of the Southwest quarter of Section 17 and the Northeast quarter of Section 18, town and rarge aforesaid. Now therefore, know all men by these presents that I, Thos. A. Tomlinson, for value received do hereby release all claims to damages sustained by me by reason of the laying out and opening said highway through my said lands above described.
