We the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Janesville in the County of Rock having by an order bearing date the 14th day of October 1862 upon due application of that purpose laid out a highway as follows: Beginning at a point where the River Road so called crosses the East and West centerline of Section 5, in said town and about 88 rods West of the East line of said section; thence in a Northwesterly direction across the lands of Edward and Micheal F. McKey to the land of Mrs. Lucy Brace about 104-1/3 rods West of the East line of said section; thence due North to the town line of said town and the Town of Fulton. And the said Edward and Micheal McKey not having released all their claim to damages by reason of the laying out of and opening said highway. We did proceed and assess the damages which such owners would sustain by reason of the laying out of such highway through their said lands to wit: To Edward and Micheal McKey or their legal representatives, we have awarded the sum of one dollar.
