We the supervisors of the Town of Janesville in the County of Rock have this day determined to lay out a highway four rods in width through the lands of Lucy Brace of said town as follows to wit: Beginning at a point where the river road so called crosses the East and West center line of Section 5, in said town, and about 88 rods West of the East line of said section; thence in a Northwesterly direction across lands of Edward and Micheal McKey to the lands of Mrs. Lucy Brace about 104-1/3 rods West of the East line of said section and, thence due North to the town line between said Town of Janesville and the Town of Fulton in said county, and across the lands of Lucy Brace 80 rods or there abouts.

We the supervisors agree to pay the said Lucy Brace for said land taken for said highway and all the damages arising on account of said road for \$300. And I, the said Lucy Brace in consideration of the sum of \$300 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged release to the said supervisors or the Town of Janesville all my right, title, interest and claim to the said described land for the purpose of said highway, done for myself, my heirs, excutors and administrators.
