Survey of a public highway made by order of the Commissioners
this 24th day of March, 1848.

Beginning at the center of Section 33 in the Town of
Johnstown on the road running East and West half a mile North
of the said town line; thence North 84 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° East along the quarter
line of Section 33, 39.70 chains to a quarter stake on the South
line of Section 28; thence Northerly 72.67 chains to the middle
of the United States road. The above described line to be the
center of the road and the road to be three rods wide.
