Survey of a public highway made this 28th day of March A.D. 1848 by order of the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Johnstown, Rock County, Wisconsin.

Beginning at the county line and running on the North line of Section 25 and 26 first South 84° West 79.40 chains; thence South 85° West 29.77 chains to the North and South road on the quarter section line of Section 26; the above courses and distances are the center of the road and the road four rods wide.
