Page 75 of Record (Maple Lane Road)

Sept. 10, 1859

Recites in part---it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be, and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Beginning at the quarter stake between Section 22 and 23, Town 2, Range 13 East; thence running West a half mile on the quarter line of said section 22 to the center of said section; thence South $85\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West, 8 chains to a point South of Henry Eaites house; thence North 69° West, 2 chains and 59 links to the centerline of said Section 22; thence West on the quarter line of Section 22 and Section 21 and Sec. 20 to the center of the road known as the Hitchcock Road. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established four rods in width.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 10th day of Septmeber, 1859. Recorded Sept, 13, 1859.

Page 10 of Record (Milton-Shopiere Road)

Dec. 16, 1850

Recites in part---it was ordered by said commissioners that a public highway be laid out and established on the East side of the dividing line between lands owned by James Burnham and James Chamberlin (in other words wholly on said Burnham's land) to commence at a road running East and West--running South on land owned by said Burnham about 300 rods to the Turtle Creek Road on Section 26 and 35. And it is hereby further ordered that said Burnham be allowed \$50 as damages.
