

and the applicants for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in each of said Towns ten days before the time of our said meeting it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit. Commencing at the quarter stake on the South line dividing Section 32 of Union and Section five in Magnolia and running thence West along said line to the South center quarter post of Section 31 of said Town of Union and Section 6 of Magnolia the line of said survey to be the center of said highway thence West on the line of said Section 31 in the town of Union and Section six of Magnolia to the West line of the East half of the N.W.¼ of Section six in the Town of Magnolia, line of said survey to be the North line of said highway thence West along the line of Section 31 and Section 6 of the Town of Magnolia to the West side of said Section, the line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is hereby established four rods wide.

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Magnolia March 20th 1860

To the Honorable Board of Supervisors of the Town of Magnolia. We the undersigned freeholders of the Town of Magnolia County of Rock and State of Wisconsin are or being desirous of having a public highway and in our candid opinion believe it to be called for by the public generally, running as follows: Commencing at quarter post between Section 7 and 8 between five and six to the Town line the distance of 1½ miles, said road to run on the Section line or as near as is thought practicable by the Supervisors.
