Accepting Prevention Grant and Amending the 2013 Rock County Health Department Budget

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Rock County Health Department applied for and was awarded a \$9,445 Prevention Grant from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services to identify and make recommendations to ameliorate environmental health risks to the ground water in one town in Rock County.

Of the approximately 13,000 private wells in Rock County, estimates indicate only 1 to 2% are tested for bacteria and nitrates each year. Of these wells, 15% test unsafe for bacteria and 25% test unsafe for nitrates. Cost-effective solutions exist to remedy each concern. Educating the public of these risks and providing them with practical options to reduce these risks is an important role of the Rock County Health Department.

While the main effort is to help provide a safe drinking water supply, identification of the environmental issues of concern to the citizens and policymakers in the community is the first step to their awareness of these concerns. Rock County Health Department provides local services (radon test kits, water analysis, lead testing) that can help citizens characterize the risk in their built environment. To increase interest and motivate citizens to take advantage of these opportunities, the results of previous tests through the health department will be entered into the GIS program to provide a visual representation of the risks in the community.

Environment Can Affect Health

A few months ago, a miniseries debuted on HBO called "The Weight of the Nation." The four-part documentary provided a startling glimpse into our country's struggle with obesity. In the 25 years between 1987 and 2010, the number of American's diagnosed with diabetes almost tripled to 20.9 million. Obesity-related medical expenses in Wisconsin are expected to reach \$2.7 billion in 2013, putting a tremendous burden on our families, businesses, communities and taxpayers. We simply cannot afford our current approach to obesity prevention. 73 percent of Americans say obesity prevention is an important priority for the government to focus on, yet Wisconsin spends \$0 on obesity prevention efforts.

The documentary stated that the environment in which we live determines our health as much as the decisions we make. This means that if you or your family want to eat fresh fruits and vegetables, but have no access to a farmers market or grocery store, it will be much harder for you to eat healthy. If you want to take a walk outside, but there are no sidewalks and you do not feel safe walking down the side of the street, you will be less likely to actually take a walk. In these cases, our environment is making it more difficult to stay healthy. Yet, if there are sidewalks, or slower driving speeds, as well as more grocery stores throughout an area, those healthy choices simply become easier to make.

Is this the first time you've thought about how our environment affects our health? You might be asking yourself, what can we do about it? *Transform Rock County*, our county's new healthy living coalition, understands how important our environment is to our health as a community. The members of the coalition want to help every community make it easier for residents to become or stay healthy. The coalition's goal is to make the healthy choice the *easy* choice in Rock County. Every community, from Clinton and Orfordville to Evansville and Edgerton, is important in the coalition's work.

As important as it is, the environment is not the only cause of our nation's growing waistlines. Agriculture, economics, food marketing, racial and socioeconomic disparities, physical inactivity, and the American food culture all play a large role in our current situation. This is not a problem that can be solved by one organization or one individual. Every individual in Rock County has a role to play in making our county a healthier place to live, work and play.
