

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Milton for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 15th day of March A.D. 1867 meet at the house of Azor Kenney in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for the purpose did proceed to examine personally such proposed highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same did then and there decide upon such application and determined to lay out said highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town the days before the time of our said meeting it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway is and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof and accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Beginning at the quarter section stake in the West line of Section 6 in said town of Milton and running thence East along the quarter line of said Section forty chains and fifty links; thence North eight chains and seventy four links to a road running to the shore of Kosk-mong Lake. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway and in our opinion a road of four width is not needed the same is established three rods in width.

Whereas upon the application of Patrick Mc Adams - freeholder residing in said town whose land is excluded from a highway, for the laying out of a private road hereinafter described. We the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 27th day of September A.D. 1867 meet at the house of Patrick Mc Adams in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such private road and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same did then and there decide upon such application and determine to lay out said private road as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a line and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such private road having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be given to all of the occupants of the land through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting it is ordered and determined that a private road be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof and accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Beginning in the West line of the highway leading from West Milton to Clear Lake in said town and one rod North of the quarter line between the North West quarter and the South West quarter of Section 21 in said town; thence West parallel with said quarter line eighty two rods to the East line of Section 20 in said town the line of said survey to be the center of said private road and the same is hereby established two rods in width.
