

Notice of meeting of Supervisors to decide upon application.

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Application having been on the seventeenth day of September 1894 duly made to the undersigned Supervisors of the town of Milton in the county of Rock by three hundred twenty seven freeholders and citizens residing in said town for a highway to be laid out as follows: Beginning in the center of highway running easterly and westerly through said section 9 in said Town of Milton 2.75 chains East of the quarter corner between Sections 8 and 9 in said town, thence North along a line parallel with the line between said Sections 11.75 chains thence Northwesterly at an angle of  $38^{\circ} 12'$  with said Section line 4.25 chains, thence North along said Section line 25 chains to the corner of Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 in said town, thence North along the line between Sections 4 and 5 in said town to a point 13 rods North of the quarter corner between said town and Sections 4 and 5, thence Northwesterly toward Lake Koshkonong to an iron stake in the south east quarter of the North-East Quarter and being lot one of said Section 5 which iron stake was recently set by O. G. Bleedhorn, County Surveyor of said County and is about 25 feet Easterly of a hickory tree, thence North  $16^{\circ}$  West magnetic meridian to end across the meandered line of Lake Koshkonong and into said Lake Koshkonong in section 5.

Notice is hereby given that we, the undersigned supervisors of said town, will meet on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 1894 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon of last day on the shore of Lake Koshkonong at what is called Charley Point, in said town, and decide upon such application.

beginning in the middle of the highway 2.50 chains East of the corner between Section 8 and 9 from thence North along a line parallel with Section line between said Sections 11.75 chains; thence Northwesterly at an angle of  $38^{\circ} 12'$  with said section line 4 chains; thence North along said Section line 25 chains to the corner of Section 4, 5, 8, and 9, thence North along the line between Sections 4 and 5 in said town 40 chains to the quarter Post on said Section line, thence North  $37\frac{1}{2}$  West magnetic meridian 14.15 chains to a stake, thence North  $16^{\circ}$  West magnetic meridian to and across the meandered line of Lake Koshkonong and into said Lake Koshkonong and in said Section 5. The line of said survey and extension is the center of said highway.

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Whereas, upon the application of three hundred twenty seven citizens of which more than six are freeholders residing in said town of Milton, for the laying out of a highway, which said proposed highway is set forth and described in said application as follows: Beginning in the center of highway running easterly and westerly through said Section 9 in said town of Milton 2.75 chains East of the Quarter corner between Section 8 and 9 in said town, thence North along a line parallel with the line between said Sections 11.75 chains, thence Northwesterly at an angle of  $38^{\circ} 12'$  with said Section line 4.25 chains, thence North alone said Section line 25 chains to the corner of Sections 4, 5, 8, and 9 in said town, thence North along the line between section corner 4 and 5 in said town to a point 13 rods North of the quarter corner between said Sections 4 and 5, thence Northwesterly through said quarter corner to an iron stake in the south-east quarter of the North-West quarter and being lot 1 of said Section 5 of which iron stake was recently set by O. G. Bleedhorn, County Surveyor of said County and is about 25 feet Easterly of a hickory tree, thence North  $16^{\circ}$  West magnetic meridian to end across the meandered line of Lake Koshkonong and into said Lake Koshkonong in said Section 5.
