1844 ORDER FOR A HIGHWAY FROM BELOIT TO SUGAR RIVER, ROCK CO.

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit holden at the house of Samuel M. Drakes in said Town on the 8th day of March A. D. 1849. It is ordered and determined that the following described line running through land not enclosed improved or cultivated which we have ordered to be surveyed shall be the Center of a highway four rods in width - to wit: Beginning on the line between the North and South half of Section N. 34 in Township No. 1 of Range 12 East where the Highway from the Village of Beloit To Sugar River crosses said section line - thence running West on said line crossing said at 71.70 chains 80 chains to Post marked one mile - thence the same course on the Centerline of Section 33 passing 1/4 post at 71.60 chains 80 chains to Post marked 3 miles - thence same course to Coon Creek 17 chains - thence North 53 degrees West 63 chains to post marked 4 miles same course passing corner Sections 30 & 31 at 4.60 chains, 11.60 chains to the Highway running from the Village of Beloit to Sugar River.

## ORDER NO. 3 OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit holden at the house of Eliazer Makinster in said town on Wednesday the 18th day of June at ten o'clock. A meeting to consider the subject of the petition of E. A. Norris and eight others - It was proved to the satisfaction of the Commissioners that notices of this meeting have been posted up as the law requires - thence the Commissioners proceeded to examine the ground on the line petitioned for and caused a survey of the same to be made the description of the line is as follows - Beginning at an angle post in a road from Picatonic to Maison (Madison) - 71 chains N.E. from a school house and on land owned by E. Makinster and running North thirty-three degrees, East 77 chains to the north line of the Town of Beloit at the N. corner of Sec. 1 Town One Range 11 and Sections 6 Town One Range 12 - which we order and determine shall be the center of a Highway of four rods in width
