ORDER 3 OF COMMISSIONERS OF HIGHWAYS
THROUGH CENTER OF 5, 9, 16, 21.

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Newark Rock County Wisconsin Territory met at the quarter stake on the north side of Section nine in said Town on the 8th day of May A. D. 1846 for the purpose of taking into consideration the subject of the Petition of for the laying out a Public Highway as follows:

Beginning at the quarter section stake on the north side of Section 9 and thence running South through the center of Sections 9 and 16 to the Center of Section 21 - thence South 11 chains, 40 links to Burr Oak Tree 12 inches in diameter - thence north 66° 15" West 13 chains to double Burr Oak 8 inches in diameter each - thence 42° 45"E. 49 links - thence South 52° 30" E. 46 chains 90 links to the Center of the Sugar River Road to Burr Oak 14 inches in diameter - thence South 12° 30" 2 chains and 29 links to Burr Oak 18 inches diameter - thence North 35° 45" E. 2 chains 37 links - about miles and 73 rods. The said Commissioners being satisfied that legal notice of this meeting has been given and having examined the ground on the line petitioned for and caused a survey of the same to be made.

I hereby order and determine the above described line to be the Center line of a Public Highway and our rods in width in said Town
