ORDER OF HIGHWAYS COMMISSIONERS NO. SIX

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Newark met at the house of William Crippen in said Town on the 29th day of June A.N. 1846 at ten o'clock A.M. to take into consideration the subject of the petition of Ransler Crosby and eight others for an alteration in the Beloit and Sugar River Road when it was proved to our satisfaction that such notice as the law requires had been given we proceeded to survey the ground on the route petitioned for --

Beginning on the West line of Section 14 - 2 chains and 43 links South of the North West corner of Section 14 - thence South 55 degrees East 97 chains and 73 links to where it intersects the Beloit and Sugar River roads variation of the needle 6½°

We order and determine that the above described line be the centerline of a Highway of four rods in width.
