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to be posted up in three of the most public places of said town specifying the commencement of said route of the proposed highway, the several tracts of land through which the same was proposed to be laid so far as known and the time and place at which we would meet to make examination and survey of said highway which notices were posted up as aforesaid it being at least six days before said meeting required a copy of said notice be served upon or left at the house of each resident upon the land proposed

to be crossed by said road.

And we do further certify that being duly satisfied that the notices required by law have been given persuant to statute we on this 23rd day of May, 1846 it being the day appointed in said notice met at the hour and place notified therein and six freeholders being present made oath that said road was required by public necessity in manner and form required by law we examined the route of said proposed highway and heard all the reasons offered for or against laying out the same, were of the opinion that such highway was necessary and proper and proceeded to lay out the same and caused a survey and description of seid road to be made which survey and description is in words and figures as follows; Beginning at the quarter section post in the East side of Section 12 in Township 2 North of Range 11 East and running thence West one mile 60 chaind and 60 links between the North and South half of said Section 12 and between the North and South half of Section 11 in same town and range to the Southeast corner of the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section 11, aforesaid, all in township and range before named. Center, Rock County, Wisconsin Territory, May 23rd, 1846.
