We the commissioners of Highways of the town of Center Rock County Wisconsin Territory, have this 13<sup>th</sup> day November A. D. 1847 laid out and established a public highway in said town. Beginning at the quarter post on the north line of Section 11 town 2 range 11 East of the 4<sup>th</sup> principal meridian and running thence south 60 chains, on line through center of Section thence running South 17° 30' West 30 Chains 25 links to center of new bridge over Bass Creek and running thence South 32° 30' west 17 Chains to road through center of West half Section 14 same town and range 6° 30' East. Thence south on half 1/4 line to the south line of Section 14; thence West 80 rods on Section line to the North West corner of Section 23; thencesouth on Section line between sections 23 & 22 and 26 & 27 and 34 & 35 to the South line of the town.

And now we the Commissioners as afore said and for said town do on the day and year first above mentioned order and declare the road as above described to be a public highway and we further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute. Said road is four rods in width.
