At a meeting of the Supervisors of the said town agreeable to previous notice and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced it is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors that a high way be laid out said town of the width of four rods and have surveyed the same to described as follows to wit: the center line of said road to commence in the middle of the street at the South West corner of Block three in the village of Bass Creek thence running North till it intersects Race Street also a public highway commencing at Myrtle Street running westerly, containing the whole of what is now called Race Street in the Village of Bass Creek of the same width as said street is now laid out.

In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands at Plymouth on the 8th day of July 1857.
