Order laying out highway  
County of Rock  
Town of Plymouth

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in the town of Plymouth we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 3 day of August A.D. 1867 meet at the house of J. D. Tyler in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application, it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same did then and there decide upon such application and determined to lay out said highway as hereinafter described, having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be given to all the occupants of the land through which said highway passes and such notice having been posted in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting. It is ordered and determined, and we do hereby order and determine, that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out described as follows; to wit commencing at a point two rods west of the quarter post on the east line of section twelve in the town of Plymouth, thence running north two rods west of said section line to a point two rods west of the Northeast corner of section twelve to intersect highway running east and west in said town pursuant to said application whereof an accurate survey has been made the line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established four rods in width.
