

CASE RD

We the Supervisors of Porter upon application duly considered have ordered and directed the following survey of a road to be made. Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the Section line between Sections 27th & 28th Town 4 North Range 11 East; thence South on the section line 60.00 chains to the road running easterly and westerly across sections 33rd & 34th past the dwelling of John H. Taylor and we the supervisors do award as damages from the laying out and opening of the above highway to John Truman on the line 40 rods, 10 dollars, to James W. Jenks on the line 80 rods twenty dollars, John W. Stevens on the line 80 rods, nominal one dollar, Kinehart & Campbell on the 160, nominal one dollar and the above described road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide.

At a duly notified meetinf of the board of supervisors of the town of Porter hild May 3rd 1856 to deliberate upon the utility of acting upon an application for the laying out of a certsin road, and we the Supervisors being satisfied that all the preliminary steps have been taken do order and direct the following survey of a road to be made. Beginning at the N.W. corner of Section 3 T. 4 N. R. 11 E.; thence South on the line between Section 3rd & 2nd 9 & 10, 120 chains to the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the West line of Section 10; thence East on the E. & W. $\frac{1}{4}$ line of Section 10, 20 chains to a point uniting with a road running N. & S. on the line dividing the E. $\frac{1}{2}$ from W. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10 and the whole length of the Road is one and $\frac{3}{4}$ miles and the above described route is hereby declared to be a public Highway four rods wide and the Town Clerk is directed to make record of the same.

WALLIN ROAD

We the Supervisors of Porter upon application duly considered have ordered and directed the following survey of a road to be made. Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ Post on the Section line between Sec. 1 & 2 T. 4 R. 11; thence South in the Section line between Section 1st & 2nd Section 11th & 12th 80.00 chains to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Post between Section 11 & 12 intersecting the road running East & West through said section line the length of road is one mile. The course according to the true meridian. Variation of needle 8°.

Survey made March 14th A.D. 1857.

And we the said Supervisors do hereby declare the above route to be a public highway, four rods wide the line surveyed being the center of the same. Dated at Porter March 14th 1857.
