

Order Laying Out of Highway in conformity to decision on appeal."

Whereas on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1903 the undersigned Supervisors of the Town of Porter in the County of Rock decided against the application to them duly made by John H. Sperry, E.S Griffith and others dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of Aug. 1903 to layout a Highway described as follows.

Beginning on the North and South quarter section line running North and South through Section 31, Township 4 North of Range 11 East, Rock County, Wisconsin, at a point where the public Highway now running North and South through the center of Section 7, 18, 19, 30 and a part of 31 in said Township 4 intersects the public Highway running from Evansville to Janesville and known as the Madison Road and run thence due South along the quarter Section line through said Section 31 in said Town 4 to the South line of said section 31 said proposed Highway crossing land owned by W.B. Van Wart, O.C. & Edd Griffith, Jacob Benkert, Jacob Elmen and the Chicago & Northwestern Railway Company.

Afterwards upon appeal taken by Frank Montgomery from the determination so refusing to lay out such Highway as aforesaid, commissioners were duly appointed to review the said determination and such proceedings were duly had before them that the same was finally reversed as appears by their decision on said appeal duly filed in the office of the Town Clerk of Porter on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. 1903 now therefor in conformity with said decision and pursuant to application before mentioned it is hereby ordered and determined that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out in said Town as follows to wit:

Beginning on the North and South quarter Section line running North and South through Section 31, Township 4 North of Range 11 East, Rock County, Wisconsin at a point where the public Highway now running North and South through the center of Section 7-18-19-30 and a part of 31 in said Township 4 intersects the public Highway running from Evansville to Janesville and known as the Madison road; thence due South on quarter line to within ten rods of Land owned by Chicago & Northwestern Railroad Co. crosses said quarter line; thence South East to land owned by Chicago & Northwestern Railroad Co. to a point 2 rods East of Railroad bridge now on said quarter line; thence South across land owned by Chicago & Northwestern Railroad Co. as near as practicable; thence South West to a point where said quarter line intersects the South line of said Section 31 said line is the center of said Highway and the same is laid out of the width of 4 rods.
