Recites in part,---It is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a alteration be and the same is hereby altered pursuant to said application, whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows: Commencing two rods South of said quarter post (between Section 27 and 28) then run West to intersect the Janesville and Beloit Road on said quarter line.

Recites in part,---It is ordered and determined and we do order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby vacated, the said highway being described as follows; to wit: Commencing at the Southeasterly corner of the Depot grounds in the Village of Afton running on the South side of the railroad tracks to the South end of S. D. Burlingame's mill on the South half of the Southwest quarter of Section 27, Town 2, Range 12.
