April 19, 1867

Recites in part,---it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby altered as follows to wit: Pursuant to said application whereof an actual survey has been made.

Commencing at a point in the East side of the highway laid out on the section line between Sections 33 and 34 in said town at a stake South 16° 30' West 98 links from the Southwest corner of Daniel Eldridge's house; and running thence North 85° 20' East 9 chains and 56 links; thence South 72° 40' East 2 chains and 70 links; thence South 89° 30' East 27 chains 95½ links; thence East 14 chains and 77 links; thence South 59° 50' East 14 chains and 37 links; thence North 88° 55' East 55½ links to the center of the railroad tracks; and thence same course at last North 88° 55' East 8 chains and 31½ links to the center of the highway leading from Afton to the Crossman neighborhood. Magnetic variation 7° 40' East.

The line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established three rods width 1½ rods each side of center of the said survey.
