### Benefits:

Base Hourly Rate:

- County is paying 7.65% of wages to cover one half of the contracted psychiatrist's FICA up to \$110,000 Social Security Maximum. After SS Max is reached County then only pays 1.45% for Medicare portion.
- County is paying 5,9% of wages as employer's contribution to the Wisconsin Retirement System.

\$144.30 (35 hours per week)

- The contracted psychiatrist is eligible for participation in the Wisconsin Deferred Compensation Fund and/or Nationwide Retirement Solutions Deferred Compensation Program. The contracted psychiatrist is responsible for all payments to this fund.
- Contracted psychiatrist may participate in the group health and/or dental plan of the County in which case 100% of the cost will be deducted from the contracted psychiatrist's bi-weekly pay.
- Mileage reimbursement at IRS rate for travel incurred within regular working hours while on official authorized business.
- County will reimburse contracted psychiatrist up to \$3,000 for costs associated with maintaining professional liability insurance.

Executive Summary: This contract is with Kathy Kowalke M.D. to serve as our Crisis Medical Director and psychiatrist in the Mental Health (AODA Division. Dr. Kowalke will work an average of 35 hours per week. This contract encompasses functions previously filled under two smaller psychiatry contracts and will allow us to improve the integration of services across the Mental Health continuum. A summary of services included in the contract includes: 1) Fulfill role of Crisis Medical Director as defined in DHS 34 Administrative code; 2) Provide Psychiatric evaluation and treatment service including diagnosis, recommendations for overall treatment, medication prescription and ongoing medication management to clients of the following Rock County Human Services Programs: Crisis Intervention, Crisis Stabilization (residential and outpatient), Janesville Counseling Center and Beloit Counseling Center; 3) Provide consultation and direction to non-

medical and nursing staff as requested or indicated to help ensure that clients are treated in a manner consistent with sound clinical practice.

# **Executive Summary for Purchase of Document Imaging Software for Human Services**

The Medical Records Division of the Human Services Department has determined that the use of document imaging technology will significantly streamline their record-keeping processes. Currently, the Medical Records Division manually files and retrieves client medical records. A project has been planned and budgeted to digitally scan medical records and to make those records available for on-line retrieval by Human Services staff. The Laserfiche software system is used for document imaging in other County departments and would meet the needs of Human Services, as well.

The Laserfiche software components that are required by Human Services include:

•	2 Full User licenses, including email integration (\$750 ea.)	\$1,500.00
•	2 Quick Fields licenses for capturing data from forms (\$595 ea)	\$1,190.00
•	2 ScanConnect licenses for using varied types of scanners (\$165 ea.)	\$330.00
•	2 Real Time Lookup licenses for data validation (\$595 ea.)	\$1,190.00
•	1 Concurrent Retrieval License	\$300.00
•	4 hours of Implementation Services (\$150/hr)	\$600.00
•	Pro-rated Software Maintenance through October, 2012	\$453.00
	Total:	\$5,563.00

Software Maintenance for 2013 will be budgeted at \$906.00.

The purchase will be made through the County's Laserfiche software provider, Cities Digital, Hudson, WI.
