I hereby certify this to be a correct plat, and the following to be a correct record of a survey made by me April 30<sup>th</sup> 1877 of the section line between the South-west quarter of section 30 and the North-west quarter of section 31 of the Town of Bradford to ascertain whether any portion of Mr. Lampshire's house extended south of said section line. From the S.W. Cor. and also from the South  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. of Sec. 30 I offsetted south 60 links and run a right line between said offsetted points with an Engineers transit, and at determined points in said line opposite and adjacent to between Eighties — either side of the

house, then offsetted north from said points 60 links and established monuments in said section line at points A & B shown on the plat. I found that at the East face of the main building of Lampshire's house, said main part of the house or building extended south of the section line 5 feet & 3 inches and including the verandah 10 feet & 5 inches and that at the west face of said main part or building it extended south of the section line 5 feet & 9 inches and including the verandah 10 feet & 11 inches

The Monument at A consists of a line Stone 18 inches long by 9 inches wide, by 3 inches thick, surrounded by a lot of small hard head stones. The Monument is on the section line & 1.45 Ch. west of line between eighties & 8  $\frac{1}{2}$  links East of East base of East wing of house produced

The Monument at B consists of a line Stone 14 inches long by 6 inches wide by 3 inches thick, surrounded by 4 hard head stones, It is on said section line and 3 feet & 9 inches west of west face of west wing of house produced — Surveyed April 30 - 1877
