Dug, found nothing

Established cor. by proportionate measurement E. & W. & by fence line N. & S. Set 1" pipe 3' long in conc. pavmnt. 1.75' E. of E. 26" Poplar N. 8 1/2° W. 172.9' to face Elect. Pole S. 35° W. 40.2' " " Ferrice end post } S. 89° W. 72.8' " "

Found cut Stone Mon. lying on ground. Destroyed in excavation for the Road. Farm owners claim the N. & S. fence to have been in line with the 1/4 stone

Established 1/4 corner by possession. Set 1" pipe 3' long in concrete pavmnt. 0.4' E. of the cen. of same.

Found 6x6 cut Stone Mon. Top 8" above ground

Set 1" pipe three ft. long in concrete pavement from A.E. Whitford's refs. 5.05' W. of E. of Conc. pavmnt. 24" Elm N. 81° 25' W. 41' Spk. on N. Side 48" " N. 60° E. 74.4' to face 40" " N. 24 1/2° E. 113.7' " " S.E. Cor. School Bldg. } N. 46° 15' W. 180.1'

Found 6" x 6" Cut Stone Mon. Set 1" pipe on top. Mon. is in line with N. & S. fence. 27.3' from N. fence 29.2' " S. "

Found 6" x 6" Cut Stone Mon. 1.4' below surface. Set 1" pipe on top. Fence E. 2.5' N. E. edge of Conc. pavmnt. 3.26' W. W. edge of W. walk 49.1' W. Cen. of 17" Elm N. 62° W. = 47.6' " " 22" " S. 50° W. = 53.8' " " 26" " S. 30° E. = 34.2'
