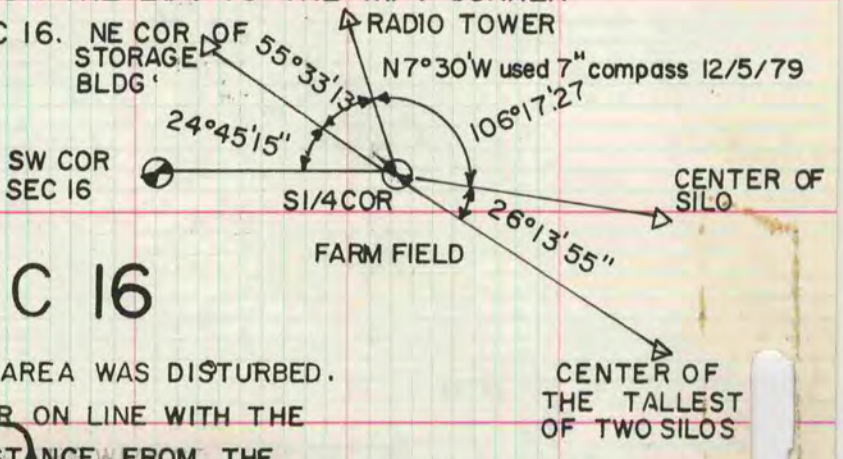

DID NOT DIG FOR THE COR, BECAUSE THE AREA WAS DISTURBED. LOCK (1864) SHOWS THE SI/4 CORNER IS NOT ON A STRAIGHT LINE BETWEEN THE SE & SW CORNER. I SET AN ALUM MON 15" DEEP. I CONTROLLED THE E/W DISTANCE BY PRORATING LOCK'S DISTANCE FROM THE SE TO SW CORNER OF SEC 16. THE N/S DISTANCE IS CONTROLLED BY PRORATING LOCK'S DISTANCE FROM THE CENTER TO THE SI/4 CORNER WITH THE TOTAL MEASURED DISTANCE & LOCK'S TOTAL DISTANCE FROM THE E1/4 TO THE W1/4 CORNER AND THE SE TO THE SW CORNER OF SEC 16.

DID NOT DIG FOR THE CORNER BECAUSE THE AREA WAS DISTURBED. SET AN ALUM MON 15" DEEP. SET THE CORNER ON LINE WITH THE E1/4 CORNER & 1/16th CORNER & EQUAL DISTANCE FROM THE E1/4 TO THE W1/4 CORNER. THIS IS IN HARMONY WITH LOCKS 1864 SURVEY & THE STATE LAW FOR SUBDIVING A SECTION THEN.
