BELOIT—Clayton Schimeall, 74, of 1732 Dewey, a surveyor for more than 50 years, died Friday at his home.

Mr. Shimeall was employed by the city of South Beloit, Ill., and R.H. Batterman & Co. Inc. before becoming surveyor for the City of Beloit, a post he held more than 20 years. For the past 25 years he had been a self-employed surveyor in the area.

Born Jan. 22, 1903, at Shopiere, he graduated from Beloit College in 1925 and was married to Vera Mills April 21, 1926, at Tampa, Fla. He was a former member of the Beloit Retailers semi-pro baseball team and a longtime supporter of youth sports programs.

Surviving are his wife; two daughters, Mrs. Joseph Dostal and Mrs. Harold Bates of Beloit; 10 grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; a brother, Clifford, Santa Paula, Calif.
