**Authorizing Purchase of Vestige View Solutions GPS Hardware and Monitoring for Use by the Rock County Motor Pool**

**WHEREAS**, the Rock County Motor Pool has a current fleet of 59 vehicles; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works and Rock County Motor Pool have prioritized safety solutions; and,

**WHEREAS**, Vestige View Solutions provides a GPS monitoring system; and,

**WHEREAS**, this option will provide safety measures for Rock County employees and our assets as well as align with the safety protocols of the organization.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Rock County Board duly assembled this 10th day of February, 2022, authorize the installation of GPS monitoring equipment and ongoing monitoring fees at a cost of \$17,692.92 per year for the duration of a three year contract for a total cost of \$53,078.76.



### Authorizing Purchase of Vestige View Solutions GPS Hardware and Monitoring for Use by the Rock County Motor Pool

The Rock County Motor Pool currently consists of 59 vehicles utilized across nine departments. These vehicles travel throughout the county and out of state on long trips for various purposes. The ability to monitor and track these vehicles provides a measure of safety for Rock County employees and their assets. The utilization on GPS equipment and monitoring makes the Motor Pool fleet consistent with practices utilized by the DPW fleet.
