Awarding Contract for Flooring Transition Strip Replacement at Rock Haven

- 1 **WHEREAS**, the 2017 budget included funds to replace the transition strips at Rock Haven Nursing

- 4 **WHEREAS**, the flooring transition strips currently in place increase the risk for a fall; and

- 6 **WHEREAS**, Halverson flooring installed a different style in one of the patient bathrooms and the fall
- 7 risk was reduced significantly; and

- 9 **WHEREAS**, these transition strips are currently located at the entrance to each Resident's bathroom and
- 10 around the dining areas; and

- 12 **WHEREAS**, Halverson flooring has the State bid #505ENT-015-FLOORING-05 for carpet.

- 14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled
- 15 this 9th day of March, 2017 awards a contract to replace the transition strips at the Rock
- 16 Haven Nursing Home in the amount of \$34,200.00, to Halverson Flooring of Janesville, WI.

Executive Summary

Awarding Contract for Flooring Transition Strip Replacement at Rock Haven

Rock Haven Nursing Home has several different types of flooring. It has sheet vinyl, carpet and ceramic tile. At the time of construction a transition strip material was installed where two different types of flooring meet that have different heights. The transition strip style that was installed sticks up 1/4 of an inch higher than the thickest flooring material creating a trip hazard.

This resolution will replace all the current transition strips with low profile transition strips to reduce the risk of falls. These strips are located at the entrance to each resident's bathroom and the dining areas. The resolution approves contracting with Halverson Flooring for \$34,200. Halverson flooring holds the current state contract for flooring.
