Upon submitting the registration form, a confirmation message will appear at the top of the screen with additional information on check-in procedures.

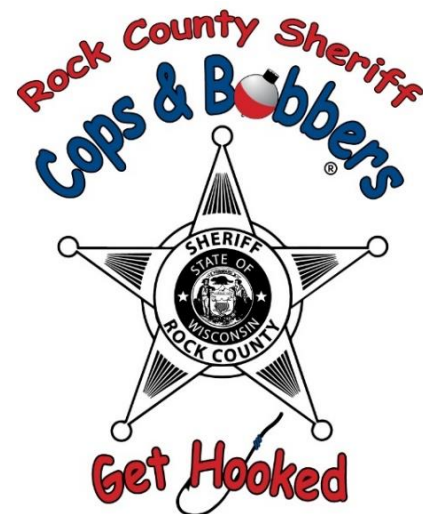
Life jackets, fishing gear, and lunch will be provided during the event. Participants will also receive a t-shirt.
