# Authorizing Acceptance of 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance (JAG) Grant and Amending 2022 Budget

WHEREAS, the Rock County Sheriff's Office, the Beloit Police Department, and the Janesville Police Department have been jointly awarded an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant, by the Office of Justice Programs, at the United States Department of Justice, in the amount of \$34,557; and,

WHEREAS, the three agencies have a written agreement that specifies the distribution of funds (Rock County Sheriff's Office \$6,911, Beloit Police Department \$14,504, Janesville Police Department \$13,142); and,

WHEREAS, the written agreement designates the Rock County Sheriff's Office the fiscal agent; and,

WHEREAS, the funds will be used in accordance with the grant application to purchase equipment and to support activities to prevent and control crime; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this <u>13th</u> day of <u>October</u>, 2022, does approve and authorize the acceptance of the 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Finance Director, under the direction of the Rock County Board of Supervisors, is authorized to accept all funds on behalf of the County of Rock, the City of Beloit, and the City of Janesville; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Sheriff's Office's budget for 2022 be amended as follows:

The Rock County Sheriff's Office, the Beloit Police Department, and the Janesville Police Department have been jointly awarded an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).
