Amending the 2022 Human Services Department Budget to Accept Mental Health Block Supplemental Funding

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) has provided additional funding to supplement current community mental health services and address unmet needs or gaps in services; and,

WHEREAS, Rock County has received \$233,348 in additional funds to be added to the 2022 budget; and,

WHEREAS, this funding is to be utilized to expand community-based services for adults with serious mental illness (SMI) or children with severe emotional disorders (SED); and,

WHEREAS, Rock County will use these funds for peer specialist services; staff training; supporting stable housing; and other projects that enhance current mental health services; and,

WHEREAS, this funding has no match requirement; and,

WHEREAS, this funding is to be used by March 14, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this <u>15th</u> day of <u>December</u>, 2022, does hereby authorize the acceptance of the Mental Health Block Grant Supplemental Funding.

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Executive Summary

Amending the 2022 Human Services Department Budget To Accept Mental Health Block Supplemental Funding

Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) has provided grant funding to supplement current mental health prevention; treatment and recovery services; and address unmet needs or gaps in services in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. This funding is in addition to the annual Mental Health Block Grant that occurs routinely.

Rock County has received \$233,348. The grant period for these funds is from 3/15/22 through 3/14/23. This funding is being used for specific projects that enhance mental health treatment and prevention services within Rock County.

The projects include maintaining contracted peer specialist services (RVCP/Compass); staff training; stable housing assistance; improving effectiveness of consumer feedback; and other projects.
