Chicago Couple Arrested on Felony Drug Charges

On January 24, 2023, at 5:48 P.M., a Rock County Patrol K9 Deputy conducted a traffic stop on a 2018 Silver Dodge Journey on Interstate 39/90 near State Highway 59 in Fulton Township. During the traffic stop, the deputy utilized his canine partner Kamo and obtained probable cause to search the vehicle. A result of the search yielded 7,095 grams (7.095 kilograms) of cocaine. The cocaine has an estimated street value of \$260,000.

Driver, Sulstine Brown-Robinson, 69-years-old from Chicago, was arrested for possession with intent to deliver cocaine (greater than 40 grams). Passenger, Tony T. Wooden, 47-years-old from Chicago, was arrested for possession with intent to deliver cocaine (greater than 40 grams). Both will make their initial appearances on January 26, 2023, at 3:00 P.M.
