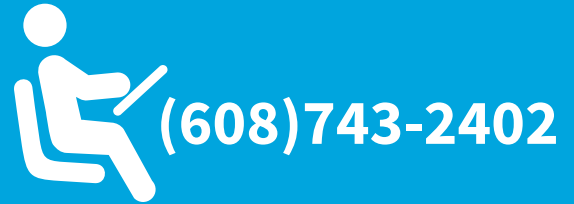




Intoxicated Driver Program

Services We Offer

Rock County residents who are court ordered to have an assessment and Driver Safety Plan must come through our office to meet that court ordered obligation.

There is a \$300.00 fee charged for that assessment. In addition, each person coming through this program, by Wisconsin state law, will be referred to either a program of education or treatment depending on the assessment findings.

A resident whose court case is still open in court may come through this program before their case is adjudicated. They will be required to prepay the assessment fee and fill out a registration form before scheduling their appointment.

The assessment results and Driver Safety Plan recommendations are reported directly to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation. Failure to follow through with a court order will result in indefinite suspension of your driving privileges.

Intoxicated Driver Program Quick Facts:

- There is a \$300 fee for the assessment and program.
- Persons with new OWI court orders are required to contact our office within 72 hours of their conviction.
- The Intoxicated Driver Program and Driver Safety Plan are always done in the county of a person's permanent residence.
- There may be additional fees for classes or treatment as part of this program referral.
- Assessments are done by appointment only and usually take about 1 hour.
- Clients will have to pre-pay the \$300 fee and complete a registration document prior to setting up an appointment.
- Payment for fees may be made by check, money order, or exact cash if paying in person. We now accept credit/debit cards as a form of payment as well.
- The Wisconsin Department of Transportation ultimately holds your driving privileges. Please contact their office at 608-261-8202 if you have questions about reinstatement or suspension.
