The Rock County Sheriff's Office is pleased to announce our continued collaboration with Special Olympics Wisconsin to host the Rock County Final Leg of the Law Enforcement Torch Run on Monday, July 10, 2023. The event will start at 10:00 a.m. with a brief opening ceremony in front of the Rock County Sheriff's Office, 200 East U.S. Highway 14, Janesville, WI 53545. At approximately 10:15 a.m., participants will run from the Sheriff's Office eastbound on East U.S. Highway 14 to the parking lot of Jimmy John's, 2929 Milton Avenue, Janesville, WI 53545. The route is approximately 2 miles. Afterwards, participants will enjoy subs courtesy of Jimmy John's.

Sheriff Fell invites the public to attend this community event to show support for Special Olympics Wisconsin athletes and public safety personnel participating in the run. Community members can participate as a runner, walker, or spectator.

There is no entry fee for those who register at the event. Anyone who wants to run or walk in the event should arrive by 9:45 a.m. for onsite registration. Onsite registrants will complete a paper registration form.
